### Streets that need to be paved

1. The circle on Smith Street
2. Kanawha Ave South 100 Block
3. Michigan Ave 500 Block
4. 8<sup>th</sup> st from 2<sup>nd</sup> to third ave and it needs milled
5. 11<sup>th</sup> st from 1<sup>st</sup> ave to 2<sup>nd</sup> ave
6. 35<sup>th</sup> st 1<sup>st</sup> ave to 2<sup>nd</sup> ave
7. Easter Road plus the small strip across the bridge
8. Small section of Lock st at the three way stop sign from main ave back to alley
9. Small portion of concrete on hillside drive at the turn around
10. A lot of concrete work in ward three
11. a lot of concrete work on third ave
12. a lot of concrete work in Brookhaven

We have a major problem on the old county road. We need our lawyer to proceed with the necessary paper work to make the homeowners insurance company to be responsible for taking out the toe that made the hillside start slipping. We need immediate action before the statue of limitation is void. At the end of the year, if we have an overage the paving committee would like for council to consider putting a lot of the money toward concrete and buy a new street sweeper
