*Nitro Airmail Cachet*



The special airmail cachet above has been designed by the post office department for airmail carried from Nitro on the first flight of a new automatic airmail pick-up and delivery service of All American Aviation, Inc., which will begin daily operations in May. A series of 56 special cachets, the most elaborate ever authorized by the post office department, will be used to mark the inaugural flights over the two routes, including service to 55 cities and towns in Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Ohio and Delaware.
