

LINE ADVANCES AIR MAIL TIME

Schedule of Charleston Pickup Is Changed

WILMINGTON, Del., Oct. 26 (AP).

—All American Aviation, Inc., announced that afternoon schedules for the non-stop pickup and delivery air mail routes over Pennsylvania, Delaware, West Virginia and Ohio have been advanced from a half hour to 45 minutes.

The change was made to permit daylight arrivals of planes at overnight terminals in Pittsburgh and Philadelphia. Morning schedules remain the same.
