## Government to Hear Bridge Permit Protest

Government engineers will hold a public heaving in the St. Allians city healt on Mondey June 12 to hear protests against the propused reissuance of a permit to the St. Albans-Nitro bridge company to build a span across the Kanawha river, connecting St. Albans and Nitro.

The government originally issued a permit to the company in 1928 to build the bridge. With laws recently passed by the legislature to permit municipalities to borrow from the Reconstruction Finance corporation for bridge building, there is considerable sentiment in St Albans for makling it a municipal venture.
