Six Safety Directors Named in CWA Plan

The appointments of six safety directors to conduct a safety campaign among civil works administration

workers on Kanawha county projects had been announced Wednesday.

The inspectors are B. J. Smith, J. W. Mitchell, J. D. Overly and Max Mitchell, of Charleston; E. R. Webb, of Burnwell, and Robert Dickson, of Reed. The campaign to instruct CWA workers in safety methods is now under way.

The names of eligible workmen to be employed on the new bridge over the Kanawha river at St. Albans are being compiled as the first step in the construction of the structure under funds provided by the civil works administration. So far as possible, the workers are to be residents of St. Albans.
